



Monaco Historic Grand Prix: Friday 10th-Sunday 12th May 2024

Hotel Check-in

All hotel rooms are booked in the guests' name as part of the Senate Grand Prix group. To check in, you simply need to show your passport at reception. You do not require a voucher or receipt. The hotel will require credit card details to cover any additional expenses or incidental costs incurred during your stay.

Breakfast and local taxes are included with all our hotel rooms. Check-in is from 15:00 and check-out is by 12:00 (Midday).

Please note: During the racing, the track is closed to the public and some of the hotels in Monaco have restricted access:

- **Hotel de Paris** will only be accessible through its side entrance on [Avenue des Beaux-Arts](#).
- The **Fairmont Hotel** will only be accessible via a temporary footbridge which is located next to the [Hotel Metropole](#). The Fairmont will be operating a remote check-in for when the track is in use, found on the [Avenue de Grande Bretagne](#). The map at the end of this document shows these locations.

E-Tickets & Ticket Collection

E-tickets will be sent to the email address used during your booking process, during the first week of May. You will receive 1 e-ticket per booking and this will be valid for all tickets within the invoice issued. Once in Monaco, you will need to swap your e-ticket for a physical lanyard & pass.

All passes are to be collected from Senate Grand Prix in Monaco. These can be collected in the following two ways:

- 1) Collect from our office in the Hotel Hermitage on Friday 10th May between the hours of 15:00 - 18:00. We will be located in the Winter Garden lobby at the rear entrance of the hotel.
- 2) If you are unable to collect your tickets on Friday, they can be collected from the entrance of your race viewing location on Saturday or Sunday. If collecting from the Fairmont, guests will need to use the metal footbridge (located next to the [Metropole Hotel](#)). Once over the bridge, keep left and you will arrive at the Fairmont Hotel roof top entrance, where you will be able to check in with the Senate welcome desk

Please bring valid identification when collecting your passes.

Race Viewing Opening Times

Our race viewing facilities will be open from the first racing of the day until the last.

On Saturday these timings will be 08:00 - 17:00, and on Sunday 08:00 - 17:45.

These timings are relevant for the below locations:

- **Garnier Suite, Em Sherif - Hotel de Paris**
- **Midi Terrace - Hotel Hermitage**
- **Metropole Hotel**
- **Fairmont VIP Suite - Fairmont Hotel**

For guests with bookings at La Salle Empire, you will be welcome at the restaurant at 12:00.

Dress-code: For the Hotel de Paris & Metropole we recommend a smart dress code. For the Midi Terrace & Fairmont Hotel we recommend smart/casual attire. Ladies are reminded that they may have to stand to view the racing so appropriate footwear should be considered.
